## 2019 March Break Day Camp Positions

The Township of Springwater is located in the heart of Simcoe County. The municipality is a mixed urban/rural community of approximately 19,000 permanent residents with growing urban settlements and a prosperous agricultural sector.

**The Township of Springwater is currently recruiting students for temporary employment during the 2019 March Break.**

Our March Break Day Camps run Monday, March 11, 2019 to Friday, March 15, 2019. Applicants **must** be available to work for the entire duration of March Break – daily, from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.

### 1. Day Camp Supervisor

Day Camp Supervisors will be responsible for the daily operation and delivery of the Springwater Day Camp program including leading / instructing staff and campers, group activities, crafts and sports. They will provide supervisor leadership to counselors and counselors-in-training.

Applicants should be outgoing, organized and able to manage multiple and competing priorities as they relate to staff scheduling, program planning, event coordination, and administrative duties. Enforcing safety rules and regulations is essential. Applicants must hold a valid First Aid/CPR certification. Experience working with children of all ages and special needs in a camp setting is required.

*Rate of Pay:* \$15.50 per hour plus statutory holidays and vacation pay as per the *Employment Standards Act*.

### 2. Camp Counselor

Camp Counselors will demonstrate and instruct sports, arts, crafts and lead various activities. They will motivate groups of campers through various games and exercises, demonstrate continuous exemplary behaviour, mentor and coach counselors-in-training.

Applicants should be positive, outgoing, personable, maintain an overall awareness of assigned campers, staff, and their belongings. Enforcing safety rules and regulations is essential. Applicants must hold a valid First Aid/CPR certification.

Experience working with children of all ages and special needs in a camp setting is an asset.

*Rate of Pay:* \$14.00 per hour plus statutory holidays and vacation pay as per the *Employment Standards Act*.

### 3. Inclusion Facilitator

The Inclusion Facilitator will be responsible for providing one to one individual assistance to identified program participants. They will assist children with special needs to allow them to participate fully in camp activities and incorporate and model the HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development where appropriate. Inclusion Facilitators will communicate with staff and family members to share pertinent information and feedback regarding participants' involvement while maintaining confidentiality. Assistance with some personal care of camp participants may be required.

Applicants must hold a valid First Aid/CPR certification. Experience working with children who have a disability is an asset. Applicants must be certified in HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development.

*Rate of Pay:* \$14.28 per hour plus statutory holidays and vacation pay as per the *Employment Standards Act*.

***An employment offer for all camp positions is conditional upon receipt of a Criminal Records Search - Vulnerable Sector Screening that is acceptable to the Township of Springwater. All required certificates must be in good standing.***
