

Re-Post 2019 Summer Student Positions

The Township of Springwater is located in the heart of Simcoe County. The municipality is a mixed urban/rural community of approximately 19,000 permanent residents with growing urban settlement and a prosperous agricultural sector.

The Township of Springwater is currently recruiting students for 2019 summer employment.

1. Public Works Assistant

Public Works Assistants are responsible for assisting and supporting in road construction, maintenance, labour duties and traffic control for the Public Works Department. Enrollment in a post-secondary program in civil engineering or planning (e.g. working towards an engineering degree, CET, or related construction technology field) is considered an asset.

Successful candidates will be required to supply their own CSA approved safety footwear as well as transportation to the daily locations. A valid Ontario Class 'G2' driver's license in good standing is required.

This position is outdoors in all weather conditions and labour intensive with a 40 hour work week. Must be available to work exclusively from May to August.

2. Recreation Assistant

Recreation Assistants are responsible for day-to-day maintenance and other manual labour duties required at Township facilities and parks. Enrollment in a post-secondary program in turf management or a recreation-related field is considered an asset.

Successful candidates will be required to supply their own CSA approved safety footwear as well as transportation to the daily locations. A valid Ontario Class 'G2' driver's license in good standing is required.

This position is outdoors in all weather conditions and labour intensive with a 40 hour work week. Must be available to work exclusively from May to August.

3. Junior Plans Examiner / Building Assistant

The Junior Plans Examiner will provide technical and administrative support to the Building Department and may also provide preliminary review of building designs. Enrollment in a post-secondary program in civil engineering or architectural technology (e.g. working towards an engineering degree, CET, or Arch. Tech. designation) is considered an asset.

This position is primarily an indoor office position with a 35 hour work week. Outdoor assistance may be required. Must be available to work exclusively from May to August.

4. Bylaw Summer Student

The Student By-law Enforcement Officer will assist with by-law enforcement activities throughout the Township, assist with the Animal Control Program and cover other staff when they are away from the office. As a By-law Enforcement Officer, the successful applicant must maintain outstanding public relations skills and a professional image in all assigned duties. Enrollment in a post-secondary program in in Police Foundations, Law & Security, Criminology, Law Enforcement, etc. is an asset. A valid Ontario Class 'G2' driver's license in good standing is required.

This position is an outdoors /indoor office position with a 35 hour work week. Must be available to work exclusively from May to August.

Employment offer for all positions is conditional upon receipt of a Criminal Records Search is acceptable to the Township of Springwater. All applicants must be a registered full-time student during the preceding academic year and provide proof of enrollment of returning to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year.

Rate of Pay: \$14.28 per hour (2018 rate) plus statutory holidays and vacation pay as per the *Employment Standards Act*.
