

Inspired by local residents competing at the Sochi Olympics in 2014, the Township of Springwater has introduced the International Competition Grant. This funding opportunity provides financial support to young athletes in Springwater competing at an international level.

The grant provides a one-time contribution of \$1,000 per specific request. Anyone applying for funding must submit a completed application form. Grants will be provided on a first come, first serve basis.

Qualifications:

- Grants will be focused on assisting Springwater youth competing at an international level
- Applicant(s) must be a resident of the Township of Springwater
- Qualifying youth must be 25 year of age or under
- Applications must be made to the grant fund prior to the event
- The Springwater International Competition Grant Committee will determine the legitimacy of the event
- The applicant must provide receipts after the event to show that the grant was used for travelling or participating in an international caliber event.

Springwater International Competition Grant Committee
Terms of Reference**

Objective

The objective of this fund is to develop a grant program to support Springwater youth that are competing at an international level.

Mandate:

1. Develop criteria to determine how the funds from a previous Springwater Golf Tournament are disbursed.
2. Determine which applicants will be referred to Council for approval of funding.
3. The funds for this grant are one-time funds and will only be available for a limited time until the funds are fully allocated.

Composition:Committee

The Committee shall consist of three Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Chief Administrative Officer and Director of Recreation, Parks and Properties.

Term of Appointment

Term of appointment will be until the funds are fully allocated.

Voting

Voting will be done at meetings, but could be done by phone or e-mail as well.

Reporting Structure

The Committee shall report to the Council as needed.

Resources:

Township staff will act as a resource, as needed.

Meetings:

Meetings will take place in a timely fashion, as required.

Protocol:

Staff will inform committee members when applications have been made, so they can be processed in a timely manner.

Authority:

Council delegates authority to the Committee to receive, assess and make recommendations to Council regarding requests for a grant from the Springwater International Competition Grant funds.

Review:

This program will be reviewed by Council on an annual basis.

Mechanics

- Applicants must be a resident of the Township of Springwater.
- Funds will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Those applying must submit a formal request.
- Grant will total a one-time contribution of \$1,000 to a specific request.
- Only one grant will be awarded to each person or group.
- Those awarded a grant will be recognized at Council and through media channels.

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- The SICG Committee will determine the legitimacy of the event.
- The applicant must provide receipts after the event to show that the grant was used for travelling or participating in an international caliber event.
