### Winter Parking

Parking is NOT permitted on roads from November 1 to March 31 between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. as per By-law 2005-18.



### Clear the Way

Remove items such as bins, basketball nets and planters from the end of your driveway and do not place steel stakes at the edge of the road to ensure the way is clear for snowplow operators.



### Blowing Snow

Don't move or blow snow onto or across the road, into ditches or onto neighbouring properties.
