The use of recreational cannabis became legal in Canada on October 17, 2018. In Ontario, the provincial government is launching a tightly regulated private retail model which goes into effect April 2019. Springwater and other Ontario communities have until January 22, 2019 to decide on whether to be part of the retail model.

SWIFT introduces a new internet coverage mapping tool

SWIFT has created in partnership with the R2B2 project an interactive map based on information received from Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) in the region. The highlighted areas have been identified as "served", meeting the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission's (CRTC) universal service objective of 50 Mbps download and 10 Mbps upload (50/10).

To further validate the accuracy of the information provided within the mapping tool, SWIFT relies on community feedback and strongly encourages questions and recommendations for coverage area changes. SWIFT will continue to update its mapping on an ongoing basis as new information is acquired.

To find your location on the interactive map, enter your address into the tool search box or zoom in on a location.

Winter Parking
