## Stay fire safe this winter as you heat your home

Did you know that fire departments often see more home fires during the winter months due to heating equipment and appliances? Prevent winter fires by paying close attention to potential fire hazards in your home and following some simple tips:

- 1 Get inspected:** Have all fuel-burning appliances inspected annually by a registered fuel contractor. Go to [COSafety.ca](http://COSafety.ca) to find a contractor near you.
- 2 Clean up:** Keep chimneys and intake/exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances free of debris, ice and snow accumulations to reduce the risk of carbon monoxide (CO) build-up from inefficient combustion.
- 3 Give some space:** Keep anything that can burn at least one metre (3 feet) from all heat sources including fireplaces, wood stoves, radiators, space heaters and candles. Turn heating appliances off when leaving the room or going to bed, or consider using timers.

Remember that the Ontario Fire Code requires smoke alarms to be installed on every storey of your home and outside all sleeping areas. Carbon monoxide alarms are required outside all sleeping areas if the home has a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage.
