## Seasonal Load Restrictions

The reduced load period in Springwater continues until April 30. By-law 2009-079 restricts loads on most Township roads to 5 tonnes per axle.

The imposed weight restriction helps protect municipal infrastructure during spring thaw, when road damage is most likely to occur.

## Springwater's 2019 Budget & Business Plan is approved

Council approved the 2019 Budget & Business Plan with a blended tax increase estimated at 1.76%. The impact of the budget is a \$67.18 increase over 2018 based on an average residential property valued at \$451,393, or \$14.88 per \$100,000 of property assessment.
