**SPRINGWATER TOWNSHIP / April 1, 2010** – Due to the recent string of nice weather and the extended forecast of dry weather for the coming days, the Fire Danger Rating has reached the high to extreme levels.

Because of the increased risk, a total fire ban has been implemented.

**Starting April 1, 2010 at 10:00 am all outdoor burning is now prohibited and all fire permits issued are now void until the ban is lifted.**
