
Fox Injured by Arrow prompts calls to Officials

SPRINGWATER TOWNSHIP / June 17, 2010 – An injured fox was spotted by a Midhurst resident prompting a call to the Township of Springwater this afternoon.

The Township's Municipal Law Enforcement Officer contacted the necessary agencies and searched the area of Doran Road and Gill Road for a fox that had apparently been shot by an arrow.

The fox was not found after an extensive search, as a result, residents of Midhurst are being asked to keep an watchful eye for the injured fox and to be guarded while walking with small children or pets in the Doran Road and Gill Road area as injured animals can be dangerous. Ongoing efforts are being made to locate the injured fox.
